Notice of Student Financial Support - The trustees of the Henry Clarke Scholarship trust are pleased to announce that they will award two bursaries this year in the amount of fourteen hundred dollars each. One each, to two eligible most qualified students entering post secondary studies in the 2022-2023 year.

Eligibility :

(1) to be eligible all applicants must be first time entering first year studies at a university or a college.
